dated 10th December 1881.

The Little Saskatchewan Reserve
Treaty 2

They are also well satisfied with the excellent Reserve which I subsequently visited granted generously to them at Sandy Bay, Lake St Martin in place of the worthless one they formerly possessed at the upper mouth of the Little Saskatchewan River. They ask that a map of the Reserve be kindly furnished them. They intend to build a School house in the Centre of the Reserve this winter. They ask for 25 grub hoes and 16 large axes.
