

OVER GROUND STOP HAVE SHOWN MR BURNS INDIAN AGENT NEWWESTMINSTER

WHAT WE WANT STOP IF YOU CAN WIRE AUTHORITY TO  
HIM TO LET US THROUGH WE WILL GIVE HIM ANY

GUARANTEES HE WANTS TO PROTECT INDIANS AND MR PRITCHARD STOP-  
FURTHER DELAY IN THIS MATTER WILL THROW MEN OUT ON

EMPLOMENT AND THERE IS NO POSSIBLE BASIS FOR OUR BEING  
INCONVENIENCED BY MR PRITCHARD
