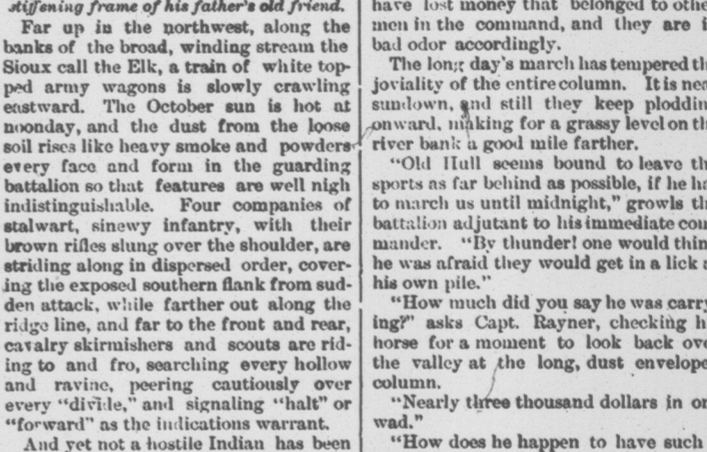

THE DESERTER.
