## LECTURE BEFORE THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SOCIETY.

Prof. Lewis H. Paton of Hartford Theological Seminary will lecture here on the evening of March 4th, under the auspices of the St. John branch of the Society of Archaeology. The subject of his lecture will be: "Palestine Before the Hebrew Conquest," illustrated by the reflectroscope. Prof. Paton was director of the American School of Oriental Study and Research in Jerusalem, and made a large collection of his own photographs which he will use in the lecture.

The purpose of the lecture is to exhibit the civilization of Palestine from the earliest times down to arrival of the Hebrews in that country in the light of the most recent investigations in Palestine itself, and the archaeological discoveries in Palestine and Egypt. He will give the result of his own investigations in these regions.
