And whereas leveral Juhabitants in Newfoundland, and other Persons, have, lince the Pear of our Lord. One thoufand ür hundzed eighty fibe, Ingrossed and Detained in their own hands, and for their own private Benefit, several Stages, Cok-Roms, Beches and other Places in the said Parbours and Creeks (which before that time belonged to fishing Ships) for taking of Bait. and Fishing and Euring their Fish, to the great prejudice of the Kilhing Ships that arive there in the fishing Season, and sometimes to the overthrow of some of their Moyages, and to the great difcouragement of the Traders there: Be it further Enacted by the Authority afore= faid, That all and every such Person and Persons, as since the said Pear of our Lozd, One thousand fir hundzed eighty five. have or hath Taken, Seized or Detained, any such Stage, Cok= Rom, Bech or other Place, for taking Wait, or Fishing, or for the Drying, Curina
