Was Presdt of the East Lambton Reform Assoc. for a number of years. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last. g.e. A Liberal.— Watford, Ont.

MCLENAGHAN, NATHANIEL. (South Lanark.)

Parents came to Canada from the Co. of Derry, Irel. in 1830, and settled in the Tp. of Drummond, Ont. B. there 17 Nov., 1845. Ed. at the Common Schools in Perth. Taught school for ten years, and afterwards entered on his present business of buying and shipping cattle to Britain, etc. Has been a mem. of the Perth Council. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g.e, A Conservative.—*Perth*.
