## BILL.

An Act to make more effectual provision for enforcing the Legal Rights of the Crown in regard to Public Works.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make more effectual provi- Preamble. sion, for enforcing the Rights of the Crown in regard to Public Works in Lower Canada: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice 5 and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britan and Ireland, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper 10 and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That whenever an action is brought on behalf of the Crown, to recover posses- Order to be sion of any immoveable property belonging to Her Majesty made when in this Province, it shall be lawful for the Court before which longing to the 15 such action is brought or any one of the Judges thereof, to Crown is order the Sheriff of the District to put such person or persons as illegally detained. may be named for that purpose by the Attorney General, Solicitor General, or other Officer prosecuting such action, and moving or petitioning for such order, in possession of the 20 property designated in such action or in regard of which such action is brought; such property to be held by such person or persons as the guardian (gardien) thereof during the pendency of such action.

II. And be it enacted, That every such order may be moved At what time 25 or petitioned for and made, at any time after the service of the such order may be made. Writ of Summons in the action, either before or after the return thereof, and either in Term or in Vacation, and shall be granted upon affidavit stating that the property in question belongs to Her Majesty, and is unjustly or illegally detained 30 by the Defendant.

III. And it shall be the duty of the Sheriff upon receipt of Duty of Sheany such Order, to put the person or persons therein named, in riff under such possession of the property therein designated and to adopt all possession of the property therein designated, and to adopt all lawful means, and to require the assistance of any force, Mili-35 tary or Civil, for that purpose.
