James fans take note

While Moviegoers prepare to experience Henry James on the silver screen with the adaptation of his *The Bostonians*, audiences in Fredericton can look forward to a live Henry James performance.

British actors Rosalind Shanks and Gabriel Woolf will perform "The Lion of Lamb House", Fri., Oct. 26 at 8:00 p.m. in The Cellar Theatre, room 139, Carleton Hall at the University of New Brunswick. They will create a Living Biography of Henry James with gestures and excerpts from his novels, short stories, letters, notebooks, autobiographies and essays.

Admission is free.

Born in New York in 1843, Henry James spent much of his life in Europe and England. "The Lion of Lamb House" will focus on the years spent in Rye, the unspoiled little medieval town, where as proud owner of the venerable Lamb House, he enjoyed the famous "third period" of his creative life.

A prolific and masterful writer of both fiction and literary criticism, the author of such classic works as *The Portrait of a Lady*, *The Golden Bowl* and *The Turn of the Screw*, James died in London in 1916.

Ms. Shanks' career includes radio drama, readings, BBC TV productions of Muriel Spark's *The Girl of Slender Means* and

Mrs. Gaskell's *North and South*, Sir John Gielgud's production of *The Gay Lord Quex*, parts in productions at Britain's National Theatre and the Mermaid, and touring the world in Shakespeare's *People* with Sir. Michael Redgrave.

Gabriel Woolf, who is well known in Britain for his readings on radio and his recital work, also writes features for radio, as well as plays. In the past year he has presented more than 20 of his different portraits or anthologies covering themes as diverse as Vivaldi, Saki or Boccaccio.
