

# Mental error hurts Mississauga cycle driver

The days of enjoying the facilities and a day of good racing at Mosport Park might slowly be coming to an end. Watching the Victoria Day motorcycle sprints proved not only hazardous on the track but also in the spectator areas as many motorcyclists churned up the grounds on their bikes scaring many bike fans.

In racing, Mississauga's Frank Mrazek ran into some bad luck over the weekend crashing his very fast Yamaha during the time trials on Saturday. He started in the expert race on Sunday and was running a strong second when he missed a shift and in over-revving the highly tuned engine on his Kawasaki 900

damaged a valve which slowed him down so much that he finally turned into the pits. Mrazek was Canadian Champion in '73 and is constantly running in the top.

The highlight of the day was the expert unlimited race which turned out to be a close race from start to finish between No. 40 Henderson on

a Kawasaki and the present Canadian Road Racing Champion Steve Baker who has earned the right to carry the No. 1 plates. Henderson led the first four laps but the meticulous preparation by Yamaha and constant flawless driving by Baker was too much for the competition. Baker gave a tremendous performance turning lap times of 1 minute 33 sec. working out to be an average speed of 95
