I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, with reference to Jules Ed. Savard, of Shell River, who has constructed a residence in error on approximately seven feet of the Indian Reserve, and advise that, as Mr. Savard has his crop placed in the cellar of the building and you report that no damage has been done to Indian property, the Department is inclined to agree with your suggestion that no action be taken in this matter until next spring. I would ask you to communicate with Mr. Savard, advising him of the decision of the Department.
