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In the next year, as the result of amendments to the Criminal Code the words "unduly and unreasonably" were restored to subsections (a) (c) and (d) of Section 520 of the Criminal Code and the word unlawfully was stricken out. The new subsection referred to above as protecting workmen in unions was added.

On April 30, 1906 a deputation of wholesale grocers waited upon the Hon. Charles Fitzpatrick, then Minister of Justice, urging the restoration of the word "unlawfully" to Section 520 of the Criminal Code, as having been omitted therefrom by oversight when the Criminal Code amendments were before parliament in 1900, but no action appears to have been taken as a result.*
