In the next year, as the result of amendments to the Criminal Code the words "unduly and unreasonably" were restored to subsections (a) (a) and (d) of Section 520 of the Criminal Gode and the word unlawfully was stricken out. The new subsection referred to above as protecting workingmen in unions was added

On April 20,1906 a deputation of wholesale grocers waited upon the Hon. Charles Pitzpatrick, then Hinister of Justice. urdging the restoration of the word "unlawfully" to Section 520 of the Criminal Code, as having been omitted therefrom by oversight when the Criminal Code amendments were before parliament in 1900, but no action appears to have been taken as a result. 4
