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ditions that have come about of recent years.

..... However, if tonight we are agreed that hon. gentlemen opposite as well as those on this side of the House favour a reciprocal agreement in natural products, then I say that the sooner we seek to bring about such an agreement the better; for surely nothing is so greatly needed at the present time as a market for our natural products, and that market the best that can be obtained."
