- (5) Kahkeyememook, No. 58, Sandy Bay Band, Manitowapah Agency, to the Long Plain Band, Portage la Prairie Agency.

with reference to the case of William West who is now being transferred to Rolling River Band, Birtle Agency, kindly do not fail to notify Mr. Agent Wheatley to withhold this man's annuity money until the balance of his indebtedness on scrip account has been wiped out.
