

INTRODUCTION

grosse [gro:s], *fosse* [fos], *position* [pozisjɔ], etc. 2. $\delta = [\circ]$ in a few words: *hôtel* [otel], *rôti* [roti], etc.

u, ü has no English counterpart; the tongue position is the same as for [i], but with tense lip rounding, without protrusion; best acquired by prolonging the [i] sound, meanwhile rounding the lips, or by rounding the lips and bringing the tongue to the [i] position — Symbol [y]: *tu* [ty], *mur* [my:r], *mûr* [my:r], *vu* [vy], *rue* [ry], *utile* [ytil], *fût* [fy], *sur* [syr].

EXCEPTION: For **u**=[u], see Semi-Vowels, below.

y when not beginning a syllable, **y** has the same sound as **i** — Symbol [i]: *syllabe* [silab].

EXCEPTION: For **y** beginning a syllable, see Semi-Vowels, below.

I. — Combinations denoting Vowel Sounds

ai, aî usually = [ɛ], see **è**, above; **aî** always thus: *mais* [me], *faire* [fe:r], *j'aimais* [eme]. *j'aimerais* [emre], *maitre* [me:tʁ].

EXCEPTIONS: 1. **ai** = [e], as in *été*, when final in verb-endings: *je donnai* [døne], *je donnerai* [dønre], *j'ai* [e]; also in *gai* [ge], and usually in *je sais* [se], *il sait* [se], *maison* [mezɔ]. 2. **ai** = [ə], as in *le*, in *-ais* of certain forms of the verb *faire*: *nous faisons* [føzɔ], *je faisais* [føze], *faisant* [føzã], etc.

au, eau regularly = [o], see **ø**, above: *autre* [oitr], *aux* [o], *eau* [o], *chevaux* [ʃøvo], *sauter* [sote], *tableau* [tablo], *beau* [bo].

EXCEPTIONS: **au** = [ɔ], see **o** above, in the future and conditional of *avoir*, and in a few other words: *j'aurai* [ɔre], *j'aurais* [ɔre], etc., *Paul* [pol], *mauvais* [møvel], etc.

ay, ey when a final sound = [ɛ]: *je paye* [pe], *Cambray* [kõbre], *Ney* [ne]; but **a** or **e** in this combination = [e] when the **y** belongs to the next syllable: *ayez* [eje], *payer* [peje], *grasseyer* [graseje].

EXCEPTIONS: *pays* [pei], *paysan* [peizã].

ei always = [ɛ]: *reine* [re:n], *Seine* [se:L].

eu, êu (1) a sound which has no English counterpart; the tongue position is the same as for [e], as in *été*, with tense lip rounding and protrusion, as for whistling; to acquire the sound, prolong [e] and round the lips, or round the lips and bring the tongue to the [e] position — Symbol [ø]. Thus pronounce **eu**, **œu** as a final sound, and also **eu** before **s** and sometimes **t** within a word: *peu* [pø], *feu* [fø], *il veut* [vø], *heureux*
