

- (vi.) **Ship** (A.S. *sci'pe, form*), as—fellowship, workmanship.
- (vii.) **Ward** (=keeper), as—Hayward, Howard, steward.
- (viii.) **Ish** (A.S. *isc*) (1) like, as—childish, boorish.
 (2) a little like, as—blackish.
 (3) like in race, as—English.
- (ix.) **Meal** (A.S. *maelum, at times*) as—piecemeal (cf. Chaucer, *stoundmeal, hour by hour*).
- (x.) **Le, er (r), k** have frequentative force, as—waddle, glimmer, talk (tell).
 Obs. : *Le* is sometimes diminutive, as—dribble.
- (xi.) **En (n), se (s)** have causative force, as—broaden, cleanse.
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
