

Ten Thousand Electors Ask Kean's Arrest Charging Him With Criminal Negligence.

TWILLINGATE To His Excellency the Governor in Council:—

The Petition of the undersigned residents of Twillingate and electors of the electoral district of Twillingate, humbly sheweth that on March 31st and April 1st last, seventy-eight sealers of the Crew of the sealing steamer "Newfoundland" died on the icefloe from exposure, and that in the opinion of your petitioners, Captain Abram Kean, Master of the "Stephano," was guilty of criminal negligence in relation to the said men, wherefore your Petitioners humbly pray that Your Excellency be pleased to direct the Law Officers of the Crown to take the necessary steps to test before the Courts the liability or otherwise of Captain Kean. And as in duty bound they will ever pray.

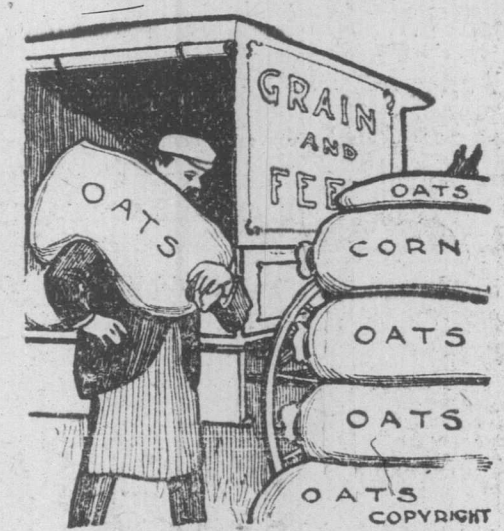
