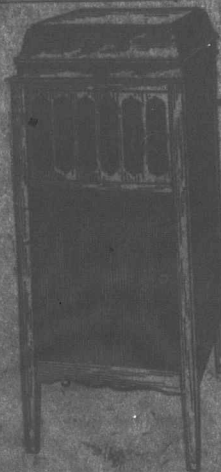

THE VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Much comment has been made relative to the Vocational School and its purpose since its activity became an established fact, due to the efforts of the gentlemen comprising the committee, which is entrusted with the development of the school. The comments made for the most part, we are glad to state, have been of a complimentary nature; it is realized by the majority of the people that the aims of the Vocational School are good and well worthy the necessary sympathetic support to make it a success. True, there are a few, a very few, who have ridiculed the project. This is not strange, it is quite natural. There always will be knockers, in fact, they are a necessary and, we might say, a useful evil in as much that rather than having a discouraging effect upon those conducting the affair, ridiculed, they stimulate them to the effort of convincing their critics that their conception is entirely wrong. However, to return to the majority, those who can readily see and appreciate the benefits to be derived from the courses given at the Vocational School, we might say that the unanimous verdict has been that "it certainly offers a good opportunity to the young boys and girls; they should certainly take advantage of it."

Now, to foster such an opinion and yet have eligible members of the family, who can well afford to spend the winter months at school, remaining at home, well, it would indicate one of two things, providing the comparatively small financial outlay is not the determining factor, and these are: That the influence of the parents in directing the welfare of the family is not truly evidenced in the home, or the family as a whole is resigned to await the verdict given the school by the students taking the initial courses.

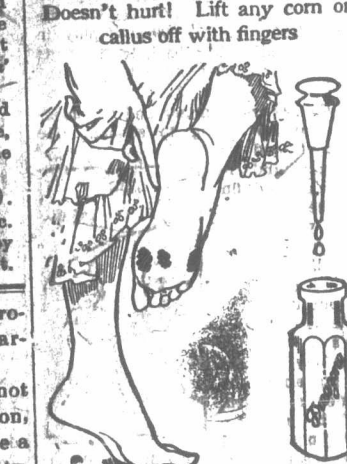
