### CL.B. Will Pay Tribute

TO NON-COM. OFFICER TREBBLE.  
The remains of the late James Trebble, son of District Chief Trebble, Fire Department, came by last evening's express in a hermetically sealed casket from Montreal where death occurred suddenly. Deceased had been studying Arts at McGill University, and, brilliant student that he was, undertook to pass a two years' course in one year, and accomplished it successfully at a recent examination. He was an ex-pupil of Bishop Field College and was a candidate for the Rhodes Scholarship this year and was looked upon as a likely winner, because in addition to his educational attainments he was an athlete of repute. On arrival at the railway station, last evening, the corpse was taken charge of by Undertaker Carnell, and, followed by a large concourse of citizens and boys with whom the deceased was very popular, wound its way to the home of the late young man's father, on Knight's Street, whence the funeral will take place tomorrow afternoon. The C.L.B. Battalion and Brass Band will attend the procession, as deceased was Sergeant in that Brigade. The funeral is expected to be one of the largest witnessed in the city for some time, as the deceased was so well known. Interment will be at the C.E. Cemetery.

### At the City Hall.

The Chairman, Messrs. Harris, Ayre, Bradshaw, Mulhally, McGrath, Morris, Anderson and Withers were present at last night's meeting of the Civic Commission.

A communication was received from the President of the Cabmen's Union asking for an interview with the Board before the proposed regulations concerning cab stands become operative. The sub-committee of the Board will meet a deputation of three cabmen and hear their views on the matter.

J. P. Blackwood wrote asking for definite information concerning Capt. Green's property. The matter was referred to the Engineer who will make a full report.

E. G. Cousens applied for permission to erect a fence around vacant land on Southside. Referred to the Engineer.

C. J. Fox, S. P. A., wrote again re the condition of certain streets and inclines in the city. A reply will be sent to Mr. Fox at an early date.

Jonas Barter, President of the Truckmen's Union wrote the Board complaining that city was not paying the Union rates to carters. The matter will be enquired into.

R. F. Horwood, LeMarchant Road, complained of condition of streets caused by the flooding of a drain. Referred to the Engineer.

Alexander Mercer, a city employee, asked for an increase of wages. The matter was deferred.

Peter Casey, Water Street West, will have to remove coach house erected without the permission of the Board.

Plans submitted by H. D. Cummins, of proposed dwelling on Hamilton Street were approved subject to city regulations.

Permission can not be given to Mrs. Grouchy to repair houses on Adelaide Street, as they are within the "fire zone."

The Colonial Secretary forwarded copy of a letter to the Government from Furlong, Conroy and Higgins, Solicitors for the Imperial Oil Company, Ltd., Canada, on the matter of the erection of a plant for the storage of inflammable oils.

A similar request was also sent the Government from the Standard Oil Co. of New York, through their agent, J. B. Truham. Both matters will be considered at a special meeting.

With a short consideration of a letter from the Overseas Club, which is given elsewhere in this issue, the meeting adjourned at 10.35 p.m.
