BRAMPTON IS SO NAMED BY the late John Elliott after his native town in England. The first settlement was about 20 years ago, and since that time it has grown, not spasmodically like some places, but slowly and surely, like what is good and never suffering a reaction. Today the town has a population of 20,000, and shows every indication of vigor and prosperity. The two business streets are solidly built, mostly of brick, and the buildings are either two or three stories and many of them of fine architectural design. There are many beautiful private residences showing both taste and culture in their owners and varying in value from \$2000 up to \$75,000, the cost of the Hargrett residence. As reported by Mr. Chagnon and estimated rapidly increasing in value, and transfers are readily made at a profitable advance. In the neighborhood farming lands run from \$35 to \$80 an acre. AN APPROOF OF WHICH ALL MEN ARE TALKING.

Sir R. D. Morier, the British Ambassador at St. Petersburg, has been fiercely attacked by the Cologne Gazette and other journals which, taking their cue from Count Herbert Bismarck, charged the minister with having taken advantage of his official position as Charge d'Affaires at Darmstadt in 1870 to convey by way of London secret information to Marshal Bazaine of the movement of German troops. He obtained from the Marshal last August an unqualified contradiction of the libel, and sent the correspondence to the German Ambassador in London.

The Foreign Office, which published the entire correspondence, which closed with a furious reply to Count Herbert Bismarck's brusque letter.
