Month when the sea-fowl shed their feathers. August; Kesagāwe-goos'.

Month when the young birds are full-fledged. September; Măjowtoogwe-goos'.

The 'running' month. 'Moose-calling month.' October; Wegāwegoos'.

Fat month; (when *tame animals* are fat.) November; Skools.

December; Ukchegoos'.

The chief month, (when christmas comes.)
