#### RULES AND REGULATIONS.

All herses to be eligible at closing of emiries. Entries for all races close July 24th, 1880, at 9 p. m., and must be addressed to 40 King St. west, Toroato. Entrance, 10 per cent. of the purse, and must accompany nomination in all cases. Trotting to a mile heats, best 8 in 5, in harness. Jockeys must a pear in proper costume, or they will not be allowed to mount. Weights for Third race will be announced at 4 p.m. c. July 27th, and acceptances by 10 a.m. on July 28tl at 40 King street west, Toronto; and for Fifth race, by 8 p. m. July 28th, acceptances by 10 a.m. July 29th, at 40 King street west, Toronto Brewers' Purse, in which Jerome Park weights must be carried. mnst be carried.




