3 Arctic waters means those waters which are located north of a line from the latitude $58^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $042^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$ to latitude $64^{\circ} 37^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $035^{\circ} 27^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence by a rhumb line to latitude $67^{\circ} 03^{\prime} .9 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $026^{\circ} 33^{\prime} .4 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence by a rhumb line to the latitude $70^{\circ} 49^{\prime} .56 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $008^{\circ} 59^{\prime} .61 \mathrm{~W}$ (Sørkapp, Jan Mayen) and by the southern shore of Jan Mayen to $73^{\circ} 31^{\prime} .6 \mathrm{~N}$ and $019^{\circ} 01^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{E}$ by the Island of Bjørnøya, and thence by a great circle line to the latitude $68^{\circ} 38^{\prime} .29 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $043^{\circ} 23^{\prime} .08 \mathrm{E}$ (Cap Kanin Nos) and hence by the northern shore of the Asian Continent eastward to the Bering Strait and thence from the Bering Strait westward to latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$ as far as Il'pyrskiy and following the 60th North parallel eastward as far as and including Etolin Strait and thence by the northern shore of the North American continent as far south as latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$ and thence eastward along parallel of latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$, to longitude $056^{\circ} 37^{\prime} .1 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence to the latitude $58^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $042^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$.

4 Polar waters means Arctic waters and/or the Antarctic area.

## Regulation 18 - Application and requirements

1 This chapter applies to all ships certified in accordance with this Annex operating in polar waters.

2 Unless expressly provided otherwise, any ship covered by paragraph 1 of this regulation shall comply with the environment-related provisions of the introduction and with chapter 4 of part II-A of the Polar Code, in addition to any other applicable requirements of this Annex."
