

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Allan J. MacEachen, is pleased to announce that within the framework of the Department of External Affairs Foreign Service Visitors Programme, the following appointments have been made for the academic year 1975-76:

Mr. David Stansfield, former High Commissioner to Malaysia and Ambassador to Burma, Foreign Service Visitor at the University of Western Ontario in London, Ontario; Mr. Paul Malone, former Ambassador to Israel and High Commissioner to Cyprus, Foreign Service Visitor at the University of Manitoba (October 15 to December 15); Mr. Paul Tardif, former deputy director of Information Division, Foreign Service Visitor at Laval University.

This programme of secondment of senior officers to Canadian universities, which is now in its seventh consecutive year, has proven rewarding both to the universities and to the Department. Under this programme, the officers are released from departmental duties for one academic year to join a university faculty or department where they are available for research, teaching, seminars and consultations related to international affairs under mutually agreed arrangements with the host university.

As previously announced, Mr. G.G. Crean, former Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany, is Visiting Fellow at the Centre for International Relations at Queen's University.
