The Acting Speaker (Mr. Laniel): Does the House agree to stand consideration of motion 13 and proceed with the consideration of motions 14 and 15?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Laniel): We will turn now to motion No. 14 in the name of the hon. member for Greenwood.

Mr. Andrew Brewin (Greenwood) moved:

That Bill C-172, an act respecting the Federal Court of Canada, be amended by striking out the words "or to federal-provincial relations," in subclause (2) of clause 41 at page 23.

Federal Court

He said: Mr. Speaker, we have made very good progress in the consideration of the report stage of this bill. The Minister of Justice has suggested to me that I might call it six o'clock, and I am very pleased to do so.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Laniel): Does the House agree to call it six o'clock?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Laniel): It being six o'clock, the House will adjourn until two o'clock tomorrow afternoon.
