

satisfy himself as to whether it is truly that sort of transaction which is exempt from the prospectus filing and it is or is not a transaction which should bring that company again within the provisions of section 17.

I move this amendment, seconded by Senator Langlois.

The Hon. the Speaker: Honourable senators, in amendment, it is moved by the honourable Senator Hayden, seconded by the honourable Senator Langlois, that this bill be not now read the third time, but that it be amended as follows:

Delete subsection 13 of section 5 and substitute therefor the following—

Hon. Senators: Dispense.

The Hon. the Speaker: Honourable senators, is it your pleasure to adopt the motion in amendment?

Motion agreed to.
