On motion of the Honorable Mr. Letellier de St. Just, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Scott, it was

Ordered, That the Honorable Messieurs Aikins. Allan, Archibald, Armand, Bellerose, Botsford, Bourinot, Cornwall, Dever, Dickson, Ferrier, Flint, Girard, Guévremont, Haviland, Haythorne, Letellier de St. Just, Macfarlane, Miller, Montgomery, Northup, Odell, Páquet, Perry, Scott, Trudel, Vidal, and the mover, be appointed a Committee on Standing Orders and Private Bills, with power to examine and enquire into all such matters and things as may be referred to the said Committee, to report from time to time their observations and opinions thereon, and to send for persons, papers and records.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Letellier de St. Just, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Scott, it was
