This is a portion of the Parish sadly needing attention. Since the little old Chapel was pulled down about three years ago, services have been held in cottages rented for the purpose, but this was running away with the money which had been collected for the building of the new Church, and eventually the cottages had to be given up. Work at this Mission is practically at a stand still. We have a site promised, and if that should fail us a site of our own, we have a lot of stone purchased by the late Rector, and we have \$600 in cash. A plan is to be prepared for a little wooden Church with a stone foundation to cost not more than \$1,000, which it is hoped will be built this fall, and then more efficient and satisfactory work can be done at St. Augustine's.
