

Secretary-Treasurer, a Recording Secretary, an Inside Sentinel, an Outside Sentinel, and a Committee of five members in good standing. All officers shall be elected annually at the regular annual meeting and hold office for one year and until their successors are elected.

2. At the expiration of the Chief Factor's term of office he shall be duly installed as a Past Chief Factor (except on the first election of officers when he shall be elected). He shall administer the installation service for the officers elected for each term and instruct the members in the secret work of the Society.

3. After the first election of officers no member shall be eligible to the office of Chief Factor unless he has served an unexpired term as Chief Factor, or full term as Vice-Factor, and no member shall be eligible to the office of Vice Factor unless he has been a member of the Society for one year, provided if all members qualified to serve decline, any member in good standing is entitled to be elected.

## ARTICLE V.

### ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

1. Nominations for officers shall be made at the meeting immediately preceding that of the regular election and on election night by consent of a majority of the members present.

2. When an officer or officers are to be elected the Chief Factor shall appoint three tellers to conduct the election. The ballot box shall be placed in front
