PRISONERS ARE STILL IN JAIL IN MONTREAL

(Canadian Press Despatch.)
Montreal, June 17.—Falling to find George S. Matepert, warden of the St. Vincent de Paul Penitentiary, either at his institution or at his home, J. Wilfred Pilon, who has been requested by C. C. Cabana, K.C., of Sherbrooke, to act as counsel in his stead presented a motion this afternoon to Mr. Justice Dugas to be allowed to serve substitutionally the judgment rendered by his lordship last Monday, granting a writ of habeas corpus to Joseph and Emilie Labrie, and ordering their release from the prison where they are now confined and also a copy of his lordship's judgment for a rule nisi against Matepert and his condemnation to one year in jail unless he shows just cause next Monday why this sentence should not be acted upon.

PRaises GROUNDS AT WOODSTOCK

(American Horse Breeder.)
It would be hard for any turf scribe to paint a word picture that would do justice to the beautiful exhibition grounds and racing plant at Woodstock, N. B., located on an island in the St. John river and within a stone's throw of the business centre of the city. The island contains 100 acres as level as a billiard table, and not a stone on the whole surface as large as a marble is to be found. Along the water's edge on all sides is a growth of shrubbery which gives an artistic finish to the whole. 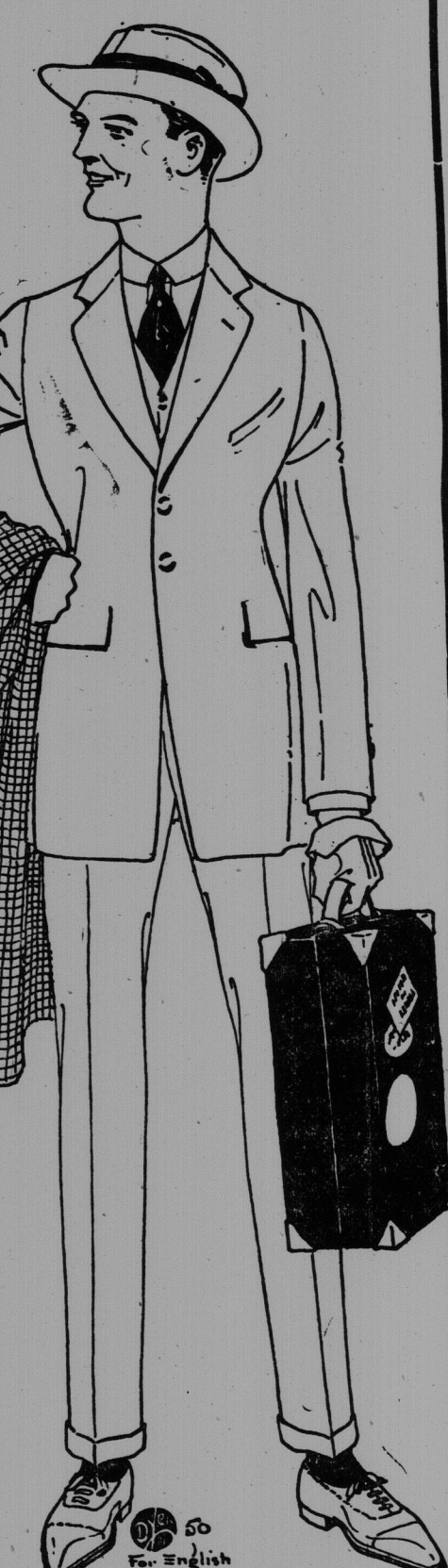
