

The Department of External Affairs today announced that Mr. Jean-Guy Sylvestre, National Librarian, National Library, will lead the Canadian delegation to the Conference of Government Officials of Francophone Countries Responsible for Scientific and Technical Documentation Policy. This conference is organized by the Agence de Coopération culturelle et technique and will be held in Paris from the 26th to the 28th of February 1973. Mr. Marcel Risi, Director of the Technological Information Analysis Section at the Quebec Industrial Research Centre will represent the Province of Quebec within the Canadian delegation.
