

OWEN, *Hon.* LEMUEL CAMBRIDGE. (*Kings, 3rd Dist.*)

Eld. s. of the late Thos. Owen, Esq., who was Postmaster Genl. of P.E.I. for eighteen years. B. at Charlottetown, P.E.I., 1 Nov., 1822. M., July. 1861, Lois, dau. of the late Charles Welsh, Esq., of Mount Edgecombe, Charlottetown Royalty. A ship-owner. Is a dir. of the Merchants Bank of P.E.I.; of the Steam Navigation Co.; and of the Marine Insurance Co. Was Postmaster Genl. of P.E.I. from 1860 to 1867. Was a mem. of Ex. Council of P.E.I., from Sept., 1870 until Apl. 1872, when he resigned with the Govt.; re-entered the Council, 30 June, 1873, and apptd. Presdt., 27 Sept., 1873, in his own administration. Sat for present seat from g.e., 1866 until 1872, when defeated; re-elected at last g.e., and again 11 Feb., 1875. A Conservative.—“*Birchwood,*” *Charlottetown.*

POPE, *Hon.* JAMES COLLEDGE. (*Prince, 5th Dist.*)

Descended from a Cornish family. B. at Bedeque, P.E.I., 1827. Ed. there. M. the dau. of Thos. Pethich, Esq., of Charlottetown. A merchant. Entered P.E.I. Assembly, 1854; and has continued to hold a seat in that body since that time, except during a few months in 1873, when he sat in House of Commons. Entered Ex. Council,
