

An Act to make l'Islet the *chef-lieu* of the District of Montmagny.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Preamble. 20 V. c. 44.
 Reign, intituled " *An Act to amend the Judicature Acts of Lower*
Canada," the village of Montmagny was appointed to be the *chef-lieu*
 for the sittings of the Superior Court for the District of Montmagny;
 5 And whereas the said village of Montmagny, inasmuch as it is situated
 near the south-western extremity of the said District, and is remote and
 difficult of access from several parts of the said District, is not a proper
 place to be the *chef-lieu* for the said District; And whereas the village
 of l'Islet, in the parish of l'Islet, is the most convenient place for the *chef-*
 10 *lieu* of the said District; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. As much of the said Act as appoints the village of Montmagny to Part of the said Act repealed; and l'Islet to be the *chef-lieu* of Montmagny.
 be the *chef-lieu* of the District of Montmagny, and the place at or near
 which the sittings of the Superior Court for the said District shall be held,
 is hereby repealed; and the village of l'Islet, in the parish of Notre
 15 Dame Bonsecours de l'Islet, shall be the *chef-lieu* of the District of
 Montmagny, and the place at which shall be held the sittings of the
 Superior Court, the Court of Queen's Bench, and the Court of Quarter
 Sessions for the said District, and the place at which the Court House
 and Gaol for the said District shall be built.

20 II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
