of the said Mayor, or the said Councillor, the remaining Councillors Councillors shall continue to exercise the same powers and fulfil the same duties empowered to act. which they would have had to exercise or fulfil, had not such decease, absence or inability to act on the part of the said Mayor or Councillor, 5 taken place.

XXI. Every Mayor or Councillor so elected or appointed to replace Duration of another, shall remain in office for the remainder of the time for which his predecessor had been elected or appointed, and no longer.

XXII. Before any person shall proceed to hold an election in con-residing offi-to take oath. Which any Justice of the Peace residing in the said town is hereby authorized to administer, that is to say:

"I do solemnly swear that I will faithfully and impartially, to the The oath " best of my judgment and ability, discharge the duties of Presiding 15 "Officer at the election which I am about to hold for persons to serve

" as members of the Town Council of Lévis : So help me God."

XXIII. The officer presiding at any election under this Act shall have Presiding offiauthority, and he is hereby required, at the request of any persons certoexamine qualified to vote at such election, to examine upon oath [or affirmation, upon oath as 20 when the party is allowed by law to affirm] any candidate for the office to qualificaof member of the said Town Council, respecting his qualification to be elected to the said office ; and shall also have authority, and he is hereby required upon such request as aforesaid, to examine upon oath [or affirmation], any person tendering his vote at any election, and the oath

25 to be administered by the presiding officer in both cases shall be in the form following :

"You shall true answer make to all questions put to you by me in The oath, "my capacity of Presiding Officer at this election, respecting your " qualification to be elected a member of the Town Council, [or respect-

30 "ing your qualification to vote at this election, as the case may be]: So " help you God."

And the presiding officer shall himself put the questions which he Hay put other shall deem necessary.

If any person being examined upon oath or affirmation under this 35 Act as to his qualification to be elected or to vote, shall wilfully forswear himself, he shall be deemed guilty of wilful and corrupt purjury, and on conviction thereof, shall be subject to the same penalties as in other cases of wilful and corrupt perjury.

The said Town Council shall meet at least once in each month for the 40 transaction of the business of the said town, and shall hold their sittings in the Town Hall or in any other place in the said town which shall Council. have been set apart for the purpose, either temporarily or permanently; Provided always, that one or several members, not sufficient to form a Proviso: as to quorum, may adjourn any meeting of the Council which may not have 45 taken place for want of a quorum, and such members, though not form- for noning a quorum, are hereby authorized to compel the attendance of absent attendance.
