An Act respecting the Cowichan Valley Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Cowichan Valley Railway Company has, Preamble. by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and 5 consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The time limited by section 12 of chapter 62 of the Time statutes of 1898 for the commencement of the railway of the extended. Cowichan Valley Railway Company, and for the expenditure 1898, c. 62.

10 of fifteen per cent on the amount of the capital stock, is hereby extended for two years from the thirteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred, and the time limited by the said section for the completion of the railway of the said company is hereby extended for five years from the thirteenth 15 day of June, one thousand nine hundred, and if such expenditure is not so made, and the railway is not so commenced and completed, the powers of construction granted to the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the railway as then remains uncompleted.
