Dear Sir -

The Indians under my charge need more land. They need land that can be cultivated, they need land that will supply them with wood, ^(the woods) as it is pretty well used up now. With more land they might keep a few cows among them. At present there is not one. A tract of land could be acquired I think near their present property at Boat Harbour.

I write some time ago about the payment of the Jaintos at their school at Boat Harbour, the man attended to the work all winter, the former Indian Agent said the Government promised a Jainto a yearly salary of \$18.00 (So the Indian says) -

There are two Indians building houses & they need assistance. Their names Jasper Prosper and Sally Paul. Could they get any help from the Department, One is a widow and the other an invalid.
