 that the method of procedure is most
 objectionable and cannot be received
 by the Department as satisfactory.

The pay sheets Nos 4126 and 4127
 are still more unsatisfactory as they
 are not receipted properly, and Mr
 McDonald's name does not appear
 as payer of the vouchers; the only
 note being that they were paid from
 annuity
