
Ottawa, February 8, 1911.

Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo replying to the communication sent you on December 12th, last, and in reply I beg to say that the Department regrets that the state of your health was such as to force you to discontinue the tour of inspection of the schools mentioned, which you had under contemplation.

It is thought advisable to outline an itinerary for some months in advance. With this object in view I should be glad if you would let the Department have the statement asked for in the letter above referred to, showing the number of schools visited during the past calendar year with the date of each visit. As soon as this is received instructions will be sent you.
