Referring to your letter of the 25th November, last, I beg to state that an order has been given to the Hudson's Bay Company to supply the Fort Smith Agency with 15 sacks of "Early Rose" potatoes, each sack containing 90 pounds, for the sum of \$67.50 delivered at Smith's Landing not later than May 24th next.

You should be on the lookout for the arrival of these potatoes and arrange to haul them across to Agency with the Department's team. You should also see that they are delivered at the Landing unfrozen and in good condition.
