20th August, 1925, and for a term of twenty-four years from 1st March, 1926, -rental to be paid (under sub-lease), #12.00 per annum.

From the foregoing it will be seen that neither of the recitals given correspond with details of Permit in favour of Campbell River Mills, Limited, or Lease No. 120, now held by Dwight C. Rounds; consequently, the Department is not in a position to take the necessary action in regard to issue of Lease for the area covered by agreement, nor to credit the \$50.00 sent under July Rent Return.

It is further to be observed that reference is made to a plan attached, but said plan appears to have been omitted. May I ask that you will be good enough to obtain and forward to the Department four copies of plan, so that one may be retained of record in the Department and one attached to each copy of lease, if and when issued to The Corporation of the District of Surrey.

Pending receipt of a full report from you, further action in this matter will be deferred.

For the purpose of reference I enclose original of proposed sub lease which you will be good enough to return with your report
