

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER

I told the Belgian Ambassador that you now thought it would be possible to reshuffle engagements so that you could accept his invitation to a luncheon in honour of General Crerar at the Chateau on Tuesday, September 18th. He asked me to tell you how delighted he was to know that you would be able to come, and to assure you that he would fully understand if you had to be the first to leave the luncheon. I told him that, with questions to be answered on the Orders of the Day every day at three o'clock, you very rarely made a luncheon engagement during the session, but were anxious, if at all possible, to accept his invitation.
