LATEST PHASES OF THE IRISH
QUESTION.
The number of Liberal Unionists
elected in Scotland at the last General
Election was fifteen. Of these the Ay-
burgh gave the largest Unionist major-
ity, viz., 1,175. It is therefore a matter
of special significance that at the by-
election in this constituency, the major-
ity for Home Rule should be now 63 on
the heaviest vote ever polled in the dis-
trict, 4,590. West Edinburgh and Ayr
were the only two of these constituencies
in which there were free elections,
and both have returned Gladstonian
Home Rulers. This indicates almost to
a certainty that at the next election the
Liberal Unionists will be swept out of
existence.
