treble costs, and have such remedy for the same as any Defendant can have in Costs. other cases where costs are given by Law.

XXI. And be it further enacted, That in case any information or suit shall be Costs when verdict brought to trial on account of any seizure made under this or any other Act seized Goods; relating to the Revenue, and a verdict shall be found for the claimant thereof, and the Judge or Court before whom the cause shall have been tried shall certify on the record that there was probable cause of seizure, the claimant shall not be entitled to any costs of suit, nor shall the person who made such seizure be liable to any action, indictment, or other suit or prosecution on account of such seizure; and if any action, indictment, or other suit or prosecution, shall be brought to trial when verdict for against any person on account of such seizure, wherein a verdict shall be given against the Defendant, the Plaintiff, besides the thing seized or the value thereof, shall not be entitled to more than two pence damages, nor to any costs of suit, nor shall the Defendant be fined more than one shilling.

XXII. And be it further enacted, That it shall be lawful for such officer, Tender of amends. within one calendar month after such notice, to tender amends to the party complaining or his Agent, and to plead such tender in bar to any action, together with other pleas, and if the Jury shall find the amends sufficient, they shall give a verdict for the Defendant; and in such case, or in case the Plaintiff shall become nonsuited, or shall discontinue his action, or judgment shall be given for the Defendant upon demurrer, then such Defendant shall be entitled to the like costs as he would have been entitled to in case he had pleaded the general issue only: Provided always, that it shall be lawful for such Defendant, by leave of the Court where such action shall be brought, at any time before issue joined, to pay money into Court as in other actions.

XXIII. And be it further enacted, That in any such action if the Judge or certificate of a eting Court before whom such action shall be tried shall certify upon the Record that upon probable cause. the Defendant or Defendants in such action acted upon probable cause, the Plaintiff in such action shall not be entitled to more than two pence damages, nor to any costs of suit.

XXIV. And be it further enacted, That all commissions, deputations and Appointments and appointments and of Revenue appointments granted to any Officers of the Revenue, in force at the time of the Officers to continue passing of this Act, shall continue in force as if the same had been afterwards in force. granted and made under and by authority of this Act, and that all Bonds which shall have been given by any such officers and their respective sureties for good conduct or otherwise, shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

XXV. And be it further enacted, That it shall be the duty of the Treasurer Appointment of of the Province for the time being, in places where a Deputy Treasurer may be required for the due enforcement of this or any other Act relating to the Revenue of this Province, to appoint fit persons, to be approved of by the Lieutenant Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, to be Deputy Treasurers in such port or place; which persons so appointed and approved of Security. shall give good and sufficient security by bond to Her Majesty for the faithful discharge of their duties respectively, that is to say: the Deputy Treasurer at Saint Andrews and Miramichi, respectively, in a sum not less than four thousand pounds; the Deputy Treasurer at Dalhousie in a sum not less than three thousand pounds; the Deputy Treasurer of Richibucto, in the County of Kent, in a sum not less than two thousand pounds; the Deputy Treasurer at Bathurst in a sum not less than two thousand pounds; the Deputy Treasurer at West Isles in a sum not less than one thousand pounds; and all other Deputy Treasurers respectively, in a sum not less than five hundred pounds; and all such bonds shall
