KUT-EL-AMARA TROOPS HAVE ENOUGH FOOD

Rising of Tigris Waters De-lays the Relieving Force.
London, Jan. 25.—General Sir Percy Lake, Commander of the British forces in Mesopotamia, has sent the following report of the situation there: "During the last 48 hours the Tigris River has risen seven feet at Kut and one-half at Amara, preventing all troop movements by land. An armistice concluded for two hours on the 22nd for the collection and burial of the dead."
"General Townshend reports from Kut-el-Amara that he has sufficient supplies, and that his troops have not been further engaged."
