Daties-Six months' residence upor and cultivation of the land in each o three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on farm of at least 80 acres solely owned upled by him or by his father

good standing may pre-empt a quarter

stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption may enter for a purchas homestead in certain districts. Prio 83.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, entitivate fifty acres and erect a hone-worth \$300.00.
