**VAN AMBURGH'S MENAGERIE.—Mr. Ferguson, agent of Van Amburgh's Menagerie, called on us this morning in reference to the unfounded reports which have been circulated by a small opposition show travelling through the country, that contagious disease was prevalent among the employees of the menagerie. Mr. Ferguson assures us that the report is entirely without foundation, and in corroboration of his statement showed us certificates from three medical men in Bradford, Schomberg, and Orangeville, that they had carefully examined every man, woman and child in the establishment within the last few days, and certified that there was not the slightest vestige of any disease among them. The public therefore need not have any fears when visiting the establishment on its arrival here on Tuesday.**

**THE POTATO BUG.—Mr. Wm. Chipchase, farmer, living on the Elora Road, near the Cemetery has just exhibited to us one of these beetles that are so destructive to the potato plant. Mr. Chipchase says that he has discovered quantities of eggs laid by the beetles on the underside of the leaf, and recommends, on the authority of his brother, now a visit to him, and resident for many years in Missouri, that the leaves on which the eggs are laid be broken off and burnt. Mr. Chipchase's brother says that the potato bug has been very destructive in his district, and that it was quite a common practice for the negroes to start out very early in the morning with tin snails, and (the insect being naturally very timid) frighten them off the potato fields in dense numbers. The eggs are said to produce three distinct broods in the season, so that potato growers will have to be constantly vigilant to watch for their destruction in the incipient stages of existence.**

### POLICE COURT.

**Before T. W. Saunders, Esq., P. M. Saturday, June 29.**

**CHIEF CONSTABLE KELLY vs. J. MILLAR.—This case, the facts of which were given at the time it first came up, stood for decision to-day when the Police Magistrate held "that the term other persons" in the 12th section of the By-law means other of the same class as farmers, and does not include a butcher, being the lessee of a market stall, dealing in butcher's meat and poultry. Dismissed without costs.**

**KELLY vs. J. SIMMONS.—This case, arising out of the foregoing one was decided to-day, as follows:—"I hold the defendant to be lessee of the market stall which he uses in the market shed, and therefore has the right to sell meat in quantities less than the quarter. Dismissed without costs."**

### DOMINION DAY.

**His Worship the Mayor has issued his Proclamation, calling on all good citizens to observe Monday the 1st of July, as a public holiday, that day being the fifth anniversary of Confederation. All places of business will no doubt be closed, and the day duly observed as the most notable in the history of our young Dominion.**
