Established 1836.

Right rev. Edouard Charles Fabre, born at  
Montreal, 28th February, 1827; ordained priest  
23rd February, 1850; elected bishop of Gratia  
nopolis and coadjutor to His Lordship Ignace  
Bourget, bishop of Montreal (*cum futura success  
ione*), 1st April, 1873; consecrated at Montreal,  
1st May, 1873; became bishop of Montreal, 11th  
May, 1876.

Most rev. Ignace Bourget, born at Pointe  
Lévis (Diocese of Quebec), 30th October, 1799;  
elected bishop of Telmesse and coadjutor to  
Mgr. J. J. Lartigue, bishop of Montreal, the 10th  
March, 1837; consecrated at Montreal, the 25th  
July in the same year; became bishop of Mont  
real the 19th April, 1840, assistant at the Ponti  
fical Throne 8th December, 1854; elected Arch  
bishop of Marianopolis 10th July, 1876.

Birtha, *in partibus*.
