Established 1836.

Right rev. Edouard Charles Fabre, born at Montreal, 28th February, 1827; ordained priest 23rd February, 1850; elected bishop of Gratianopolis and coadjutor to His Lordship Ignace Bourget, bishop of Montreal (*cum futura successionem*), 1st April, 1873; consecrated at Montreal, 1st May, 1873; became bishop of Montreal, 11th May, 1876.

Most rev. Ignace Bourget, born at Pointe Lévis (Diocese of Quebec), 30th October, 1799; elected bishop of Telmesse and coadjutor to Mgr. J. J. Lartigue, bishop of Montreal, the 10th March, 1837; consecrated at Montreal, the 25th July in the same year; became bishop of Montreal the 19th April, 1840, assistant at the Pontifical Throne 8th December, 1854; elected Archbishop of Martianopolis 10th July, 1876.

Mgr. Pierre Adolphe Pinsonnault, bishop of Birtha, *in partibus*.
