Scientific and Useful.

OYSTER FRITTERS.—Drain off the juice, and add to it a cup of milk, three eggs, salt and pepper and flour enough to make a thick batter; stir in the oysters; drop from a large spoon into hot lard to fry.

BLACKBERRY SYRUP.—Take four pounds of fully ripe berries, and add to them three pounds of granulated sugar and one pound of some tart, well flavoured apples, pared, cored, and sliced. Boil all together for forty-five minutes. Skim, pour into glasses, and cover closely.

BREAD FRITTERS.—Cut thin, round slices of bread, butter them very thinly, spread with jam and stick together in pairs. Fry in boiling lard, after dipping them in a batter of one egg, one pint of milk, a pinch of salt and flour enough to make a pancake batter. Pile high on a dish and sprinkle with sugar.

CINNAMON BUNS.—When making bread reserve a quart of the dough, and work well into it a teaspoonful sugar and half a teaspoonful butter. Roll out half an inch thick, and cut into long, narrow biscuits, spread them thickly with sugar and cinnamon, let them rise until light, and bake in a quick oven.

SALLY LUNN.—This is good for both breakfast and tea. A pint of sweet milk, two eggs, butter the size of an egg, two tablespoonfuls sugar, two teaspoonfuls baking powder, a teaspoonful salt, and enough flour to make a stiff batter. Mix all well together and bake in a buttered pan in a quick oven. Use hot.

PLAIN MINCK PIE.—Two quarts of chopped meat, two quarts of chopped apples, one quart of sugar, one pint of molasses, one pint of water in which the meat was boiled, one quart stoned raisins, one tablespoonful of ground cloves, two of cinnamon, two nutmegs, two tablespoonfuls of salt, moisten with cider.

MINCED HAM AND EGGS.—A nice way to use up remnants of cold boiled ham is to mince it, and to half a pound of ham melt a tablespoonful butter in a frying pan, add the ham and a little hot water, let it heat up quickly, then spread it on buttered toast, and on each piece lay a poached egg. Quite a tasty breakfast can thus be made from what at first thought might seem very unpromising.

A NICE WAY TO COOK PEARS.—Place a dish of ripe, juicy pears in a steamer and cook them until tender, then pour enough boiling water into the dish to come up around, but not over them. Sprinkle over a teaspoonful sugar to each small dish of pears, or more, according to the quantity. Bake them in a hot oven until nicely browned. Quinces are nice cooked the same way, after being pared and cored.

DELICIOUS SANDWICHES.—The most delicious sandwiches are made with bread one day old, and the following dressing: Take yolks of two eggs beaten to a cream; and half pound of best butter, three tablespoonfuls of mixed mustard, a little pepper and salt; beat all together very smoothly and set on ice. Chop very fine some tongue and ham; add a little cold chicken or roast beef if you have them. Cut the bread very thin and spread it with the dressing. Spread the chopped meat between and press together very hard.

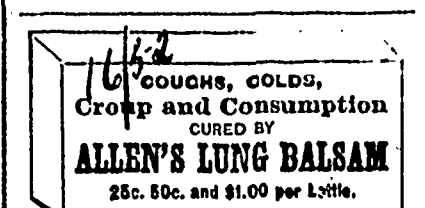
