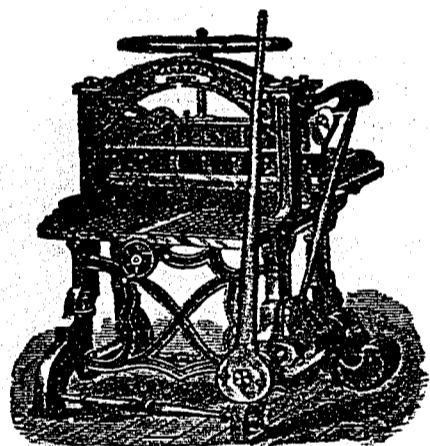

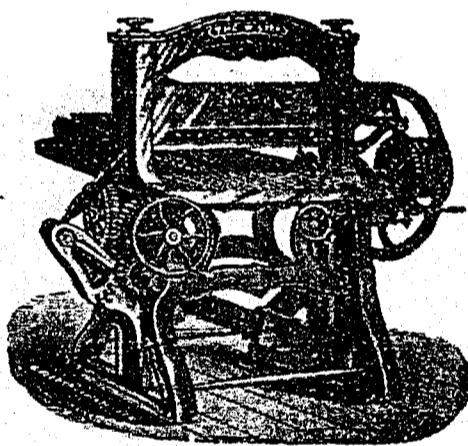
A NEW REPRESENTATIVE.

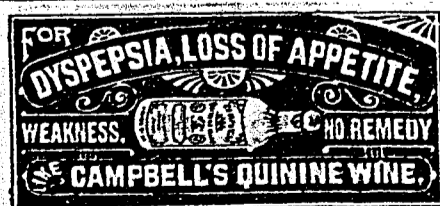

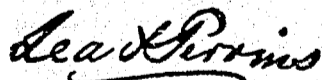
